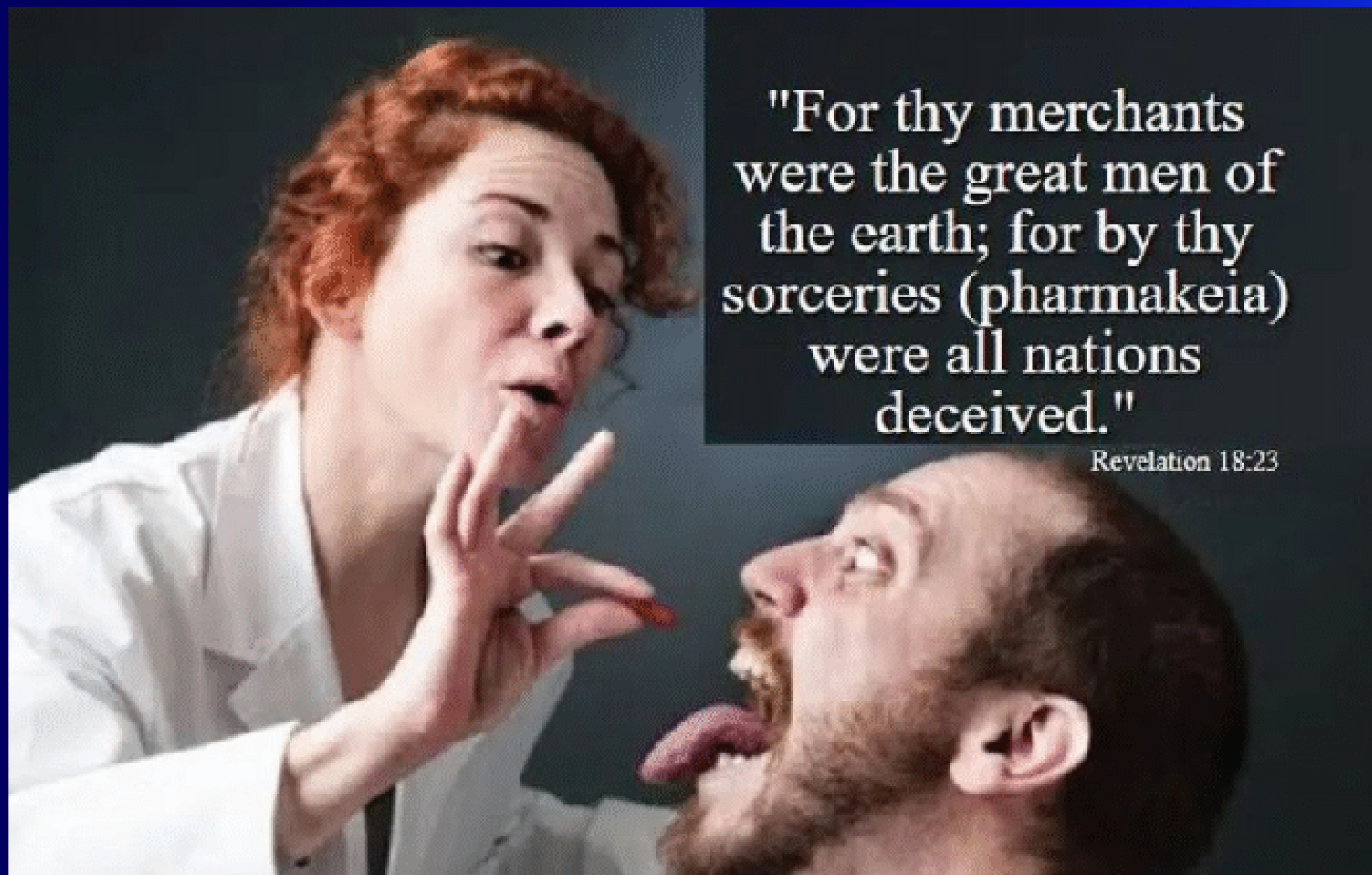

### Finality of Babylon's Fall

#### REVELATION 18: 21-24

**21** Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw it into the sea, saying, "Thus with violence the great city Babylon shall be thrown down, and shall not be found anymore.

**22** The sound of harpists, musicians, flutists, and trumpeters shall not be heard in you anymore. No craftsman of any craft shall be found in you anymore, and the sound of a millstone shall not be heard in you anymore.

**23** The light of a lamp shall not shine in you anymore, and the voice of bridegroom and bride shall not be heard in you anymore.

**For your merchants were the great men of the earth, for by your sorcery (Strong's G5331 pharmakeia) all the nations were deceived.**

## Avoid Wicked Customs- Occult Practices

### Deuteronomy 18

**9** “When you come into the land which the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominations of those nations.

**10** There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, **or one who practices witchcraft**, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or **A SORCERER ( Strong’s H3784)**,

**11** **or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead.**

**12** **For all who do these things are an abomination to the Lord, and because of these abominations the Lord your God drives them out from before you.**

**13** You shall be blameless before the Lord your God.

**14** For these nations which you will dispossess listened to soothsayers and diviners; **but as for you, the Lord your God has not**

## Aaron's Staff Becomes a Snake

### Exodus 7

**1** So the Lord said to Moses: **"See, I have made you as God to Pharaoh, and Aaron your brother shall be your prophet.**

**2** You shall speak all that I command you. And Aaron your brother shall tell Pharaoh to send the children of Israel out of his land.

**8** The Lord said to Moses and Aaron,

**9** "When Pharaoh says to you, 'Perform a miracle,' then say to Aaron, 'Take your staff and throw it down before Pharaoh,' and it will become a snake."

**10** So Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and did just as the Lord commanded. Aaron threw his staff down in front of Pharaoh and his officials, and it became a snake.

**11** Pharaoh then summoned wise men and **SORCERERS**, and the **Egyptian magicians** also did the same things by their **secret arts**:

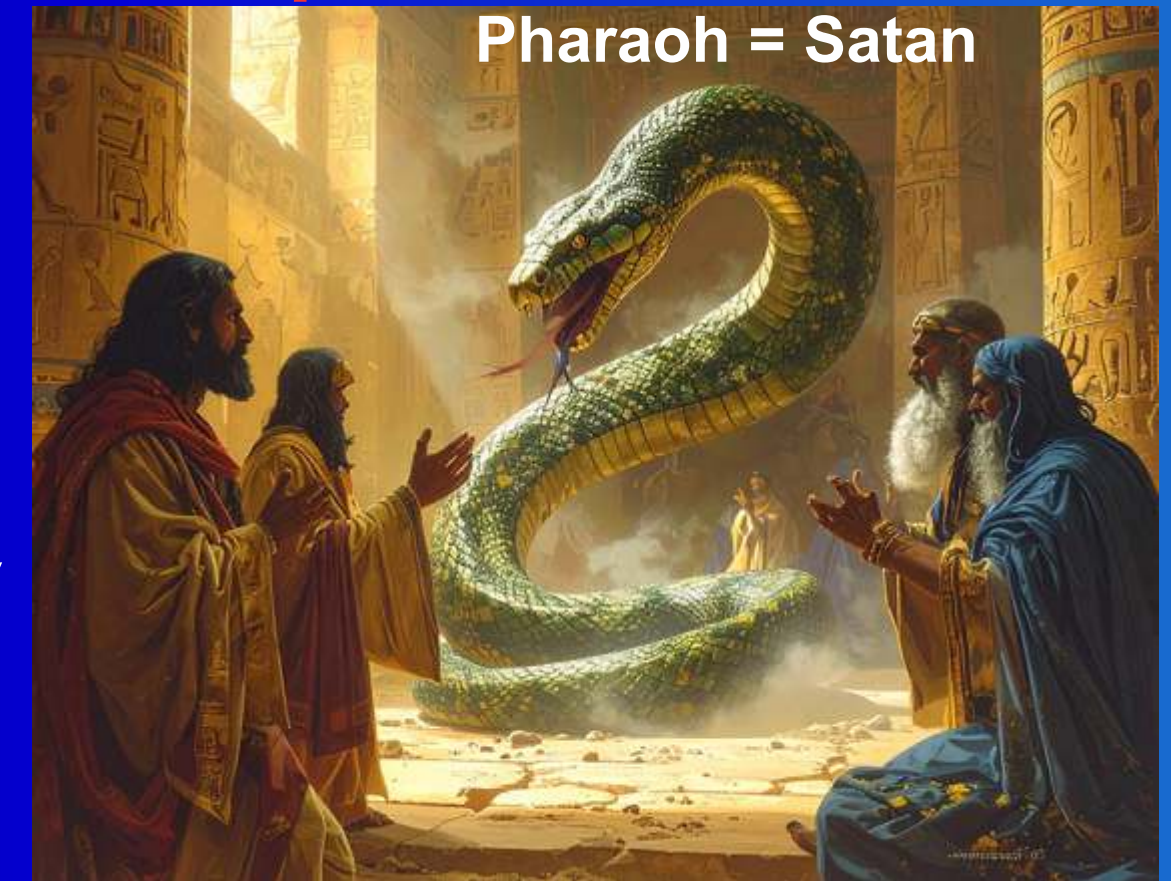
**12** Each one threw down his staff and it became a snake. But Aaron's staff swallowed up their staffs.

**13** Yet Pharaoh's heart became hard and he would not listen to them, just as the Lord had said.

**The Lord is able to devour Satans sorcery demons & serpents by overcoming them!**

**MARK 16 v17** And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues;  
**18** they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well."

serpents of witchcraft!**

### 2 Timothy 3 NKJV

**1** But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come:

**3** unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,

**4** traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,

**6** For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts,

**7** always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

**9** but they will progress no further, for their folly will be manifest to all, as theirs also was.

## Works of the Flesh GALATIANS 5

**19** Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,

**20** idolatry, **SORCERY** (Strong's G5332), hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies,

**21** envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

I break all ungodly agreements & soul ties with the doctors, psychiatrists, pharmacists & Manufacturers.
