9 For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

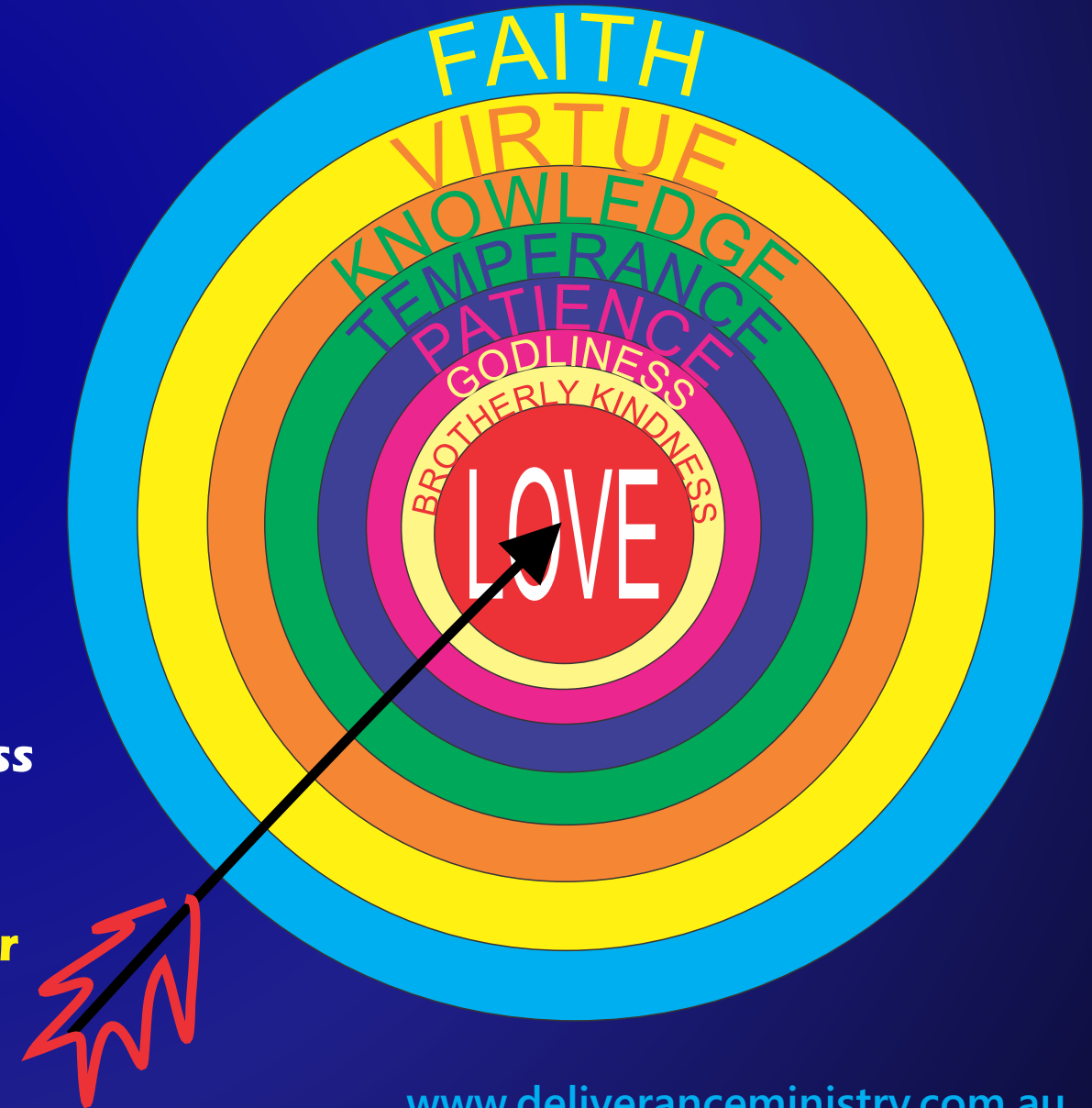
5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;

TEMPERANCE - MEANING...

Temperance in the Bible refers to self-control, moderation, and restraint in thought, word, and action, guided by the Holy Spirit.

Definition and Core Concept

Biblically, temperance is the practice of self-control and moderation, encompassing restraint over desires, impulses, and behaviors, not limited to alcohol but extending to all areas of life (Galatians 5:22-23**).**

It is considered a fruit of the Spirit, enabling believers to live in alignment with God's will and resist the control of fleshly desires such as greed, lust, or gluttony (Romans 7:21-25**).**

The opposite of temperance is self-indulgence, which can lead to spiritual and moral
